

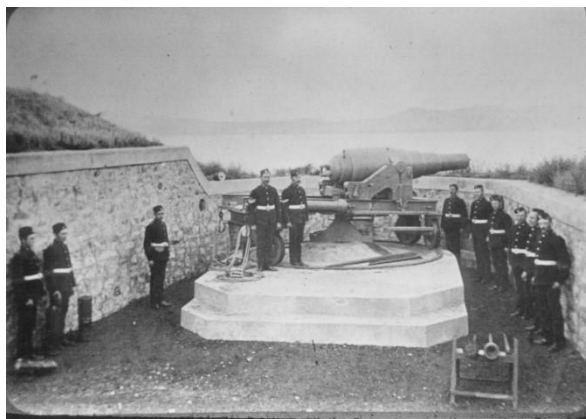

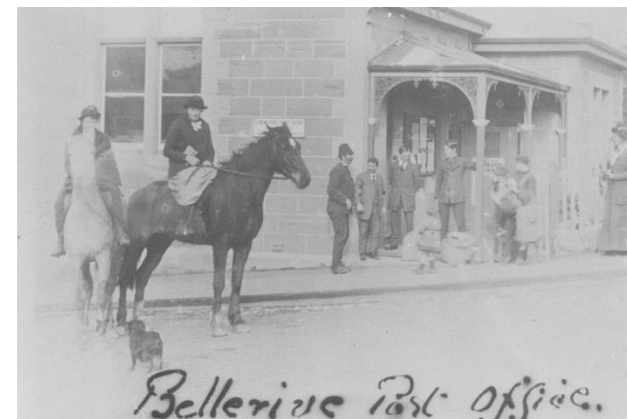
We live in a historic suburb on Mumirimina country. First settled by Europeans in 1805 and separated from Hobart Town by the river, Bellerive relied on ferry access before the first bridge was constructed in 1943.

Kangaroo Point, later renamed Bellerive (French for 'beautiful shore'), was the hub for river, road and rail transport to Hobart



from the east and south east. Bellerive developed in its early years as an independent community starting a rich history.

Early Bellerive industries were boat building and quarrying stone for export. It was the site of the Clarence Town Hall. Notable old buildings are the Police Watch House, 1842 (home of BHS); St Mark's Chapel, 1852; the Social Institute, 1867; the Fort, 1884; the Post Office, 1897 and many 19th century heritage-listed homes.
